Hong Kong, Taiwan, Indonesia, Japan, Macau and the Philippines. Of course the goal of CBGlobal is to reach outside of the scope of Asia. Did you know there are healthy CB church plants in other countries like India, China, Portugal, Argentina, Brazil, Zaire, Italy, Ivory Coast, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Jordan, France, Senegal, Madagascar, Uganda, Austria, Rwanda, Bangladesh, and Myanmar? Here is the exciting news. Groups of churches in countries where there is a Conservative Baptist identity will be invited to join the CBGlobal Family in order help fulfill the Great Commission to the "remotest part of the earth."

Recently one of my friends heard we were going to Disney World with all of the grandkids in 2013 and asked, "What will that be like?" I asked, "Have you ever been there?" No was the answer. Trying to explain my experience at the CBGlobal Meetings is like trying to explain Disney World to someone who has never been there. It is nearly impossible, but allow me to share a few personal highlights:

- God is mightily at work. Hundreds of churches are being planted all over Asia. Did you know there are over 1,200 CB churches in Asia alone with members that exceed 100,000 strong? Vision 2025 (2025 Churches by Year 2025) was set in 2007 and by God's grace over a thousand churches has been planted. Amazing!
- The Gospel transcends all cultures. Jesus said look at the fields. They are ripe for harvest. I saw thousands of young people walking the streets in Manila night and day that are searching for truth in their lives. Did you know that hundreds upon hundreds of people are coming to faith in Christ in Asia? I heard story after story from CB pastors how the Spirit of God is moving in their countries.
- Asian pastors have similar hearts. I spend a lot of time with pastors. In their hearts they genuinely want to experience a healthy church; the salvation of lost souls; the discipling of new converts; the development of servant leaders; the

transformation of communities; and so much more. As leaders from seven countries, we spent hours each day discussing, strategizing and praying how to accomplish similar goals. I was blessed to see that the heart of pastors in Asia was exactly the same as pastors in America.

- CBAP (Conservative Baptist Association of the Philippines) 50th Celebration. So often we see churches dropping "Baptist" from their name and minimizing their association as a Conservative Baptist. In Manila, I attended a five hour celebration of CBAP in a sold-out stadium that housed over 4,000 CB Filipino pastors, leaders and church members. Honestly, I have never witnessed such a level of joy, worship and celebration among so many CB's. At one point I heard hundreds of young people chanting, "CB! CB! CB!". I thought I had died and gone to heaven. They absolutely loved their heritage and that was so much fun to experience.
- The streets of Manila are somewhat safe. I was up the first night with jet lag and only had two hours of sleep. The time you ask? It was 4:00 am and so I decided to run the streets of Manila. It was a near disastrous decision. After a mile or so I decided to "run around a block" to get back to the hotel. Bad idea! I was headed down a dark, winding and unmarked street by a river with shady looking people the entire way. I hit a dead end and my first thought was . . . I am going to die! After a prayer of protection I headed back to the main road. As I joyfully arrived I was met by an armed security guard with an assault rifle. He said to me, "Are you an American?" That was obvious. The next question was, "Are you running?" Another obvious question as I was dripping sweat at 5:00 am. He said to me sternly, "Don't ever run down there again." So I didn't!

We often get so focused on our own little world of ministry in the US and we forget that God is working well beyond our borders.

One of the best parts of the weekend for me was being able to see a young man who I had the privilege of being his counselor a few of the summers that he attended camp here and seeing him return to Pine Trail Camp now as a Youth Pastor and the Director of the Blizzard SnoCamp. Pastor Jason Wilson and many others have caught onto something that the Christian Camp and Conference Association called the Power of Camp, and they give the following reasons that easily answer the Why Camp? question.

The Power of Camp for your youth group:

 Build Community - Give your youth group kids an opportunity to build deeper relationships with you and each other through shared experiences away from the routine

- distractions of daily life.
- Spiritual Focus Getting close to God's creation and away
  from the noise and technology that consume teen life gives
  students a chance to hear from God, perhaps for the first
  time. With engaging, relevant speakers and time for you to
  help students process what they're learning, many will come
  face-to-face with God's love in a life-changing way.
- Intentional Connections At camp, you won't be competing for your students' time and attention. You'll get those rare moments to share activities and talk about the important things you've been wanting to bring up.[1]

Today, when I run into students who I had worked with during my years as a youth pastor, the time they spent at camp when they were younger is always one of the top three topics they mention. Our conversations often go like this: "Remember when at camp...That was the best!" Or as one young man said to me, "Those days at camp were some of the best days of my childhood." 
